Chanape sdEIA Permit Receives Ministerial Sign-Off

Following on from Inca Minerals Limited's (Inca or Company) ASX announcement 26 March 2015 the Company is pleased to advise that its semi-detailed Environmental Impact Assessment (sdEIA) permit application has received ministerial sign-off meaning the sdEIA is now officially "granted".

The granting of the sdEIA effectively means the permitting process is largely completed and Inca need only obtain a certificate to commence operations before drilling at Chanape can commence. This is mostly administrative with the requisite site visit by government already having been undertaken.

Now in Peru, Mr Ross Brown (Inca's Managing Director) said "Inca is one of only a handful of Australian companies that have been granted a Category II permit and possibly the only Australian company to be granted an sdEIA under the recently introduced regulatory regime. The certificate to commence operations is already well advanced and site preparation, including access and installation of camp facilities in readiness for drilling, has commenced."

The Company will continue to keep shareholders advised as soon as further information becomes available.
